# RRMC grad killed while diving

A recent Royal Roads Military College graduate was one of two sailors killed last weekend in a diving accident off Gibsons, north of Vancouver.

Acting Sub-Lieut. Nicole Patricia Schiele, 22, graduated last year from the college after serving as the cadets' public information officer.

"She was an outstanding cadet — very well liked amongst the staff and the all the cadet wing," said Capt. Bob Duncan, Royal Roads spokesperson.

Schiele and Able Seaman Sandy Jacob Schreurs, 21, disappeared shortly after 5 p.m. Thursday during a training dive from HMCS Saskatchewan, said Lieut. Denise Laviolette.

A third member of the diving team returned to the surface.

Following a two-day search involving military, coast guard and RCMP, the divers' bodies were found at 9 p.m. Saturday.

Laviolette could not speculate on the cause of the accident, but said a board of inquiry has been convened to investigate.
